WWT’s patented Living Machines are ecological wastewater treatment systems that utilize natural processes operating in wetland environments and enhance these processes with hydraulic and computer systems. This family of technologies is designed to treat a wide variety of wastewater for reuse using no chemicals and only a small amount of supplemental energy, while having no odors or exposed water surfaces. The wetland vegetation promotes a complex and stable ecosystem providing nearly complete nitrogen removal and advanced BOD and TSS removal. Water treated by the Living Machine system is ideal for agricultural irrigation, landscaping, or certain industrial processes.
